ARAWAK, NIGHT 6

The tribe is unfazed by the loss of Brianna and are preparing for the next Immunity Challenge.

Bob Dawg - Yes, we must be wary. If we lose again, maybe we should boot Morgan, as Gary is stronger, will be seen as a threat, and is a free agent, meant for us

Rafe - Yeah, her or Gary. Who knows what other people will agree with, though.

Bob Dawg - I think your influential

Rafe - I guess we'll find out! I'm certainly not going to just let them get rid of me without a fight.

Rafe discusses the Tribal Council with the rest of the tribe.

Bob Dawg - Absolutly, I was thinking about a 3 way alliance with ou, me and Rafe in the merge

Jamie - LOL. We'll need more than that!

Bob Dawg - I can swing Judd

Jamie - LOL. We'll need more than that too. Gary bugs the living SHIT out of me.

Bob Dawg - Really, whats wrong with him?

Jamie - Umm, he's barely ever here and he's in the dominant alliance. I never talk to him. How he did that I don't know. Are you close with your former Caquetios members? And what is the dominant alliance over there?

Bob Dawg - Aras/Terry/Misty/Danielle/Melinda/Shane, and it seems Courtney and Cirie are on the outside. How will we break them up?

Terry - She was also humping, being annoying and digging for info. sigh. Thank god we didn't bring her in the 5, we'd be stuck with that slut. ARGH! She's here! Hide your rings.

Danielle begrudgingly speaks with Misty.

Danielle - I take it that it's been going slow tonight? Nice to have a day off tomorrow though.

Danielle - I probably won't hang around too long. I don't think there will be much going on tomorrow but I'll still drop by.

Danielle - Oh yes. The back-to-back thing should make things go faster but it shouldn't be too hard to check with the others regarding who should go if we lose. Seems like most of the discussion happens before each challenge anyway.

Misty - I'm assuming people will go with the people who don't show up a lot (Melinda or Aras) since that's the fairest way to do it and keep our tribal unity. I guess you never really know, but that would be my bet.

Misty - **CONFESSIOAL** - The odds are not good but it's not completely hopeless or impossible. I've done my best to paint Aras and Melinda as inactive targets. I hate to do that but they aren't around enough for me to talk to them or count on them for anything. The main thing that's working in my favor right now is that the Rotu 4, as I like to call them, can't afford to alienate anyone in this tribe when there could be a switch or shuffle coming up.

Terry - I'm about to shoot myself in the brain. (sending this to Shane too)

Danielle - If she's going to change the topic all time she should at least be good at it.

Terry - Yeah I know. Sigh. At least we're having fun. She's STILL here? Maybe we should send her weirder and weirder pms or something. Just to freak her out a little. Like, talk about a possible alliance with Rafe at the merge. Something completely nuts. 😊

Danielle - Lmao, She'd explode trying to change the topic on that one.

Terry - Haha Misty guts, all over the shelter. Lulz.

Courtney talked to me tonight, and it seemed more like the Spanish Inquisition. "I heard you were the one behind getting Bob Dawg out." Yeah, no shit. I saved my own ass from going home and targeted someone else. Sorry, it's a game and someone has to take control

ARAWAK, DAY 7

Jamie - hey, Gary long time no talk. What's up dude?

Gary - hey dude, not much just popping in. reading some stuff hows things wit you?

Jamie - Just okay. Trying to figure out how we can stop from being decimated. 😊

Gary - last challenge was lame, it could've gone either way. hopefully, we can get a surprise performance from somewhere. maybe from mr. pissy pants 😊

Jamie - Who is Mr. Pissy pants. lol. BobDAWG? I hope it isn't a swap.

Gary - No, it's Rafe. I was complaining to Morgan last night about how pissy he was at TC and since Bri's been gone he's gone all loopy. like he's "on the inside" or something.

Judd makes sure that Rafe is aware of how he worked to save him. They get focused for the next Immunity Challenge realizing the severity of their situation.

Judd - I'm happy you made it through that vote on Friday. Sorry I couldn't be there to offer emotional support, but apparently I did enough swaying to make sure Bri left instead of you - even though I didn't realize it would be as close as it was. I was shocked to come in Friday afternoon and discover the tides had randomly turned against you, so I was happy to do what I could and convince everyone that you could be trusted whereas Brianna could not. And to think she had the nerve to say she offered more to us than you, or anyone else. Fortunately, I got Jamie and Morgan to agree with me, so you're sticking around, like you deserve to. Anyway, I'm glad to see you here, and I can only hope tonight is the night that the fortunes of Arawak finally change. After 3 crushing losses, it's time for us to pull a Morgan or an Ogakor. By the way, did anything important happen this weekend after the vote? I wish I could have been here, but I have to admit, the ski trip was quite worthwhile anyway.

Rafe - Not much happened that I was aware of. Brianna was all angry at TC that I didn't just act like I wanted everyone to vote me out, it was kind of funny. I wasn't 100% sure I was staying, just because you never know, but I wasn't just going to not say anything. She got kind of hostile. I kind of figured Gary was the other vote for me, just because I can't see anyone else giving a voting commentary of "Meh". We absolutely need to win tonight to avoid getting completely slaughtered come merge.

Judd - Yeah, I think Brianna was just surprised to learn she was in danger, and didn't realize it was because we simply couldn't trust her. I noticed that she overreacted quite a bit. Stupid, stupid people. 😊 Tonight's win is crucial, not just numerically, but to keep our pride in check. If we lose tonight, there's no possible way to *not* be the post-merge minority, and our collective self-esteem will probably be absolutely destroyed. Rafe - It does suck that there aren't any good reasons to get rid of anyone any more. Gary would have been my choice for the next one off too. Hopefully we'll win and it won't matter, but since TC is right after the challenge I just wanted to have an idea what was going on, just in case.

Judd - Yeah, our small group size hurts, and losing another challenge would just be miserable. It's hard to do much planning with just us around here, which is why I'm figuring it'll probably be a last-minute decision before TC, simply because that's when everyone will be present to discuss, but I still think it'd be Gary, if anyone.

Judd - CONFESSIOAL - My god. If there was ever any doubt that I'm in utter control of this game and that the people I'm competing against are absolute sheep, it was quashed Friday

Rafe - Yeah, winning is pretty much a necessity at this point. I hate that TC is right after the challenge!

Jamie - I hope we all make it. If Gary doesn't show up and we lose I think his fate will be sealed no matter what!

Rafe - I hope so, damn it! It would suck to get voted out before someone who isn't even around most of the time. We have to win sometime, it may as well be tonight.

CAQUETIOS, DAY 7

The Misty smear campaign continues when Aras, who is seldom active, arrives.

Shane - ARAS, SHANE NEEDS TO TELL U SOMETHIN SO LISTEN UP. THIS IS THE MOST IMPORTANT PM SHANE WILL HAVE IN THIS GAME YET. YOU HAVE BEEN TARGETED BY MISTY TO GO NEXT. HOWEVER, SHANE DOESNT WANT THAT TO HAPPEN, SO THE VOTE IS GETTING TURNED AROUND ON MISTY BY OTHERS ON THE TRIBE, SHE IS TO SNEAKY TO KEEP AROUND. MISTY ALREADY GOT COURTNEY WITH HER TO VOTE YOU, THE OTHERS I THINK ARE VOTING MISTY OUT. PLUS, U CANNOT GO TELL THIS TO MISTY OR COURTNEY, KEEP IT ON THE DOWN LOW TILL TC, WHEN WE ALL VOTE HER OUT. WHAT DO U THINK.

Aras - WOW. That is a shock to me. I didn't know people would get so nasty so quick. Oh well. Honestly, I know I am not around that much Shane, but you are one of the people I am most closest too, and thanks so much for telling me about it. I am totally in for voting her out, and I promise I won't say a word.

Shane - NO PROBLEM, EVERYONE ELSE SHANE HAS SPOKE TO SEEMS TO HAVE THE SAME IDEA TO VOTE OUT MISTY, BUT COURTNEY IS WITH HER. IF WE LOSE TOMORROW, IT WILL BE MISTY

WHO GOES. HER REASON FOR TARGETING U WAS BECAUSE YOU AREN'T AROUND MUCH, BUT I LIKE YOU, AND WON'T LET HER DO THAT.

Danielle - Hey Aras, I've been debating whether or not to tell you this in my head, but I think you should know. I and some other people have been getting messages from Misty and she's subtly telling us she wants you out because "you're not here all the time". Please don't tell her I told you, but I don't want you to leave. You help us all the time in challenges and you seem like a nice guy. Some others have told me that Misty's sending the same stuff to them. 😊

Aras - Shane just told me this too. We need to get her out! I can't believe she is playing so nasty so quick. So much for the love tribe...huh?

Danielle - Damn, I'm glad Shane told you so I don't look like I'm trying to stir the pot! Yeah, I agree with getting her out. When she told me that I was like "Uh, wtf? We haven't even lost a challenge yet. Do you think you could wait until then?"

Aras - CONFESSIONAL - Basically, I think Misty is rubbing people the wrong way, and when she finally put her neck out there, and suggested I go...people got pissed and decided that it was the perfect time to turn it around on the bitch! I think she voted for Terry because she was comfortable with him though so they might have been in an alliance. When I talked about Shane that night when I was talking to you and her she seemed interested in what I thought of Shane so I think you may be right. I know Terry and her talk a lot together too...I am going to be much more careful what I say around them. Thx you for letting me know!

Misty - I agree that Cirie was way too comfortable with them. And Shane and Terry are just playing up the fact they didn't like the vote. That night Cirie made a list to include Danielle and Shane and made it quite clear that she thought there would be a "backlash" if Danielle's name was brought up, trying to make her look like she had a lot of support. I think Danielle is tight with them as well.

Courtney - Yea I still think there might be a Shane, Cirie, Terry, Danielle, and Melinda alliance with the rest of us on the outside...Shane doesn't like Aras and others like Danielle said they would rather have Melinda over Aras even though she has posted the least...I think we may be in trouble girl...I hope not though. I hope we are being paranoid

Misty - I hope so too but the way some people react after I say things to Terry or Cirie makes me think otherwise. We've got a buffer with Aras at least, which I hope to hell they are being truthful about. We really cannot afford to lose any challenges. A tribe shuffle if it happens could give us a better chance as well.

Courtney - Yea I totally agree. Wat do you mean by how some people react after you say things to terry or Cirie?

Misty - When I talked to Terry last night, he made it sound like it was my decision for who to go after. It was quite condescending. I really don't like the way they are doing things here at all.

Courtney - That does not look so good but at least no one is going after you or anything like that. I wonder why they are calling you the leader tho...

Misty - You mean they actually referred to me as that to you? They are trying to set me up for later if they have to so they can protect themselves. Simple as that. It's very transparent. If they ask, you can say that I've asked you what you thought when there was discussion about the vote before the challenge. But we can't let on that we talk this much about what is going on. We're on shaky ground as it is. I'm going to log off and on so that it's not so obvious we're talking now.

Cirie - CONFESSIONAL - I'm not underestimating my competition, that's for sure. This game is not over and the other tribe can easily stage a comeback. They got rid of their stragglers and they're now a team of well-bred horses. In some sense, I think my tribe has gotten a little lazy. I mean, we haven't needed to eliminate anyone yet. Terry and Danielle laugh over Courtney and Misty's supposed ignorance.

Bob Dawg - She will be

Jeff Probst - Gary, Aras, your first numbers will be 01, and you must follow this order until you reach 100 for Arawak and 90 for Caquetios. If you screw up, you must start over

As the tribes prepare for the challenge to begin, they strategize on the most effective methods.

Rafe - Let's win finally

Judd - Couldn't agree more, Rafe. If I have to go to TC yet again tonight, I will literally drop dead. I'm so sick of that damn place, and I'm so sick of Caquetios never having to taste defeat.

Misty - I can do it.

Aras - Aras, Cirie, Danielle, Misty??? That good with everyone?

Danielle - My neighbors wireless is pretty fast. On it right now. Don't give me shit about it, because it could help us win.

Courtney - Good luck guys! Hey let's help plan their numbers ahead of time everyone

Cindy - GO!!! WTF was with Bob's comment? Is he usually a sarcastic ass?

Terry - Wow Bob's being a MAJOR ASS tonight. 😞

The tribes begin the challenge and it is proving to be a close race. Arawak counts to 20 while Caquetios is still in 12. However, with their advantage in the challenge, Arawak is actually 2 behind. Morgan - Good job though Tacos <3

Judd - The stuff to throw us off at the end was brilliant. 😊

Morgan - Now you all will get the feel of tribal council, perhaps we could show you around?

Rafe - Judd, aren't you supposed to be yelling at them for being poor sportsmanships, man?

Danielle - Thanks. Good game. If you ever see Margaret again....tell her I love her.

Jeff Probst - You may be seeing her tonight Danielle, I suggest you all go back and strategize.

Rafe - Don't let Jeff push you around at TC, he's a big meanie!

ARAWAK, NIGHT 8

The mood at Arawak is one of celebration. They have finally come together as a tribe and defeated the seemingly invincible Caquetios tribe.

Jamie - **CONFESSIONAL** - WE WON! YAY! I have a sneaking suspicion that Caqueitos threw the challenge but I don't give a damn. I am just SO elated!

Jamie - Congrats on the challenge man. I am just dissapointed I couldn't win it w/ you guys.

Gary - it feels pretty damn good man

Jamie - Yeah, it does. I wish I could have won w/ you.

Gary - me too buddy

Jamie - YAY! We won...Good job RAFE!

Rafe - I was so worried I was going to fuck it up. I had about 6 windows open.

Gary - that felt awesome great job man 😊

Rafe - You too! I had about 6 windows open so I could have all the numbers in them, and I was just praying I wouldn't accidentally enter the wrong one.

Gary - That was so f'ing great I'm so happy

Rafe - Me too. I was pretty worried.

Gary reaches out to Bob Dawg.

Gary - big up to you for trying to help us win the reward. I thought that was awesome of you 😊

Bob Dawg - Oh thanks, glad I'm appreciated

Gary - seriously man, I thought it was a great thing to do

Gary - that felt friggin great 😊

Judd - Dude, it was fantastic. All of a sudden, I have new hope for this tribe. No worry about the vote, no strategizing, no having to turn anybody loose. We're completely safe, all of us, for a while. And we still have enough numbers to potentially go into the merge evened up. It's just great on all fronts. I'm going to enjoy this as long as I can.

Gary - so awesome. we kicked their ass, even before they screwed up.

I mean, I didn't tell him I would be voting off Rafe with him and I am glad I didn't. He just told me how he was voting and I told him I'd see how the others were voting.

We were on the outside and I'm worried people might switch their vote in the eleventh hour. Please let me know if the votes change!!!

Misty - Of course. I've heard Aras now. Are you hearing the same?

Cirie - I've honestly heard from a few people that they're blaming you for the loss. 😞 But, the only two names that are popping up are Melinda and Aras.

Cirie - CONFESSIONAL - In general, I'm not sure that the alliance of 5 trusts one another right now. I'm at least in hot water for fraternizing with the enemy. Aras - Should I ask Terry about his vote? I dont want him to feel pressured, but I dont want Misty getting to him first.

Danielle - Ok, I'll talk to him too. I won't let you go before Misty!

Aras - CONFESSIONAL - There was a plan, started by Misty, to get me out because she felt like I wasn't here enough (uh hello...has she seen MELINDA????) Anyway, I got two separate PMs from Shane and Danielle telling me about this, so I think the plan is debunked now, and her ass is going. If it all works out, I will so be working with Shane and Danielle from now on.

Misty continues to check whom everyone is voting for.

Misty - So whose name have you heard so far? Are you still going for Aras?
