# Stranded in Venezuela

Upon arriving at the beach, the tribes learn that they will have Tribal Council later tonight to determine their tribe leaders, or Tribe Caciques. They are told that the Caciques will play an important role in the tribe and make important decisions.

# Mariche, Day 01

The Mariche tribe, which will always wear red, consists of:

**Gabriel** - I will be social, smart, and do whatever it takes to get people to like me. If it means to be really gossipy to one person but really nice to another, i'll do it.

**General** - Of course you're always going into a game with the intention the win. I want to win of course. I'm not arrogant, so I dont think I will win this easily. I'll do my best and I really want to make as fas as possible!

**Gina** - The way to stay alive in this game, at least initially, is to play for the team. I know we've got a shrewd group on this tribe, so I'm just going to go with whatever the group really wants.

John - John is pretty unmemorable. I wont be. Thats all you need to know.

**Patricia** - I want to be in the decision making process without actually making the decisions. The less fingers that point blame to me the better. Of course, I do want SOME enemies because it's never a bad thing, so I may taunt the other tribe somewhat. Single a few people out if I can, maybe even get my hands a little dirty with some tribe mates early on, but that's all theoretical. I've just got to take this round by round and play with these other players at their speed.

**Peter** - There is a very thin, fine line between arrogance and confidence, and that's exactly where I am right now. I really think I have the social skills and Survivor know-how to win this game. But, I know if I go in too cocky, and thinking I'm the best, I will get burnt.

**Sarah** - i'll try to play a decent social game. I want them to notice me but I don't want to be a social threat and I certainly don't want to talk myself into a hole and bring out "Evil Sarah." That's not how I want to present myself during this game. I want to play a great game.

**Sean -** I'm very confident that I can win. I just need to get my footing this round.

**Vecepia** - My strategy is to stay under the rader during the premerge while getting into a good alliance. Then I will try and survive during the merge by not making enemies while taking out threats.

Sarah and Vecepia are the first to greet each other and they waste no time discussing the one thing that's on everyone's mind: Cacique.

Sarah - Hi Vecepia! I just wanted to say hi before the first event. This is so exciting for me so I hope to hear back soon. Good luck!

**Vecepia** - I'm also excited for the first event.

Sarah - Yeah, I'm excited to elect a leader. Who are you thinking for that vote?

Vecepia - I don't know. It's too early to tell. What are your thoughts on possible candidates?

Sarah - Yeah, it's pretty early but of course we only have an hour and a half to decide. It's so hard to figure this out that fast.

**CONFESSIONAL – Sarah** - OH MY GOD VECEPIA... I just can't deal with this girl right now. I sent her a nice, friendly message to reach out to her and maybe get a conversation going and she responds with the dullest response I have ever gotten. Ever. EVER. "I am also excited for the first event." WHAT?!?! That's all you have to say? You can't even feign interest in me or excitement for the game? I certainly didn't feel any excitement from your message. That's so dull and boring.

**Vecepia** - What's up. What are your thoughts on the leader vote?

Gabriel - Hey Vee! I don't know yet. Any standouts?

Vecepia - Sarah seems to be very outgoing.

**Gabriel** - So as of now you would say her? She doesn't seem too bad. Have you asked her if she wants to be? I don't want to vote for someone that doesn't wanna be the leader you know?

Just as the tribe was getting to know one another and figure out who might be a good candidate for leadership... Jeff makes an announcement to the tribe and it throws a major cog in their plans.

**Jeff Probst** - ...Just one more thing about tonight's vote: the Cacique (leader) gets Immunity until the merge for as long as they want it.

**CONFESSIONAL – Gabriel** - *IMMUNITY UNTIL THE MERGE?Oh my god. Ultimate temptation. AAAH!* **CONFESSIONAL – Sean** - *I was definitely interested, I mean how could you not be. But I feel as though it is a double edge sword so I wanted to have someone close that I thought I might trust down the line to have it. Plus it is going to put me in a power position from day 1, and that means target come merge. I'm more of a puppet master pulling the strings behind the defense of my warriors. They can take the hits in battle, but I dont want to start really being noticed as a threat until the merge.* 

Gabriel - Hey there Sean. How are ya?

Sean - hey man, I'm pretty good. I was just about to message you haha, had it all typed out, but you got to me first. How are you doing?

**Gabriel** - Oh, my bad! I'm doing really well. Did you see what Probst just sent us? My jaw dropped

Sean - haha its all good. Yea! Big twist, should make things very interesting.

Gabriel - It already is! Dude I have no idea what to do right now. Sarah said she would love to have it but so would everyone! BIG DECISION MAN!

**Vecepia** - Hi Sean. Was just about to do the same. What are your thoughts on the upcoming leader vote? **Sean** - I'm down for voting with whoever feels the most confident in taking on the position, but if no one wants it I'd also be happy to take it on. Still trying to get my bearings on the new blog site though. What are your thoughts?

**Vecepia** - From my first impression of her.... Sarah seems like she could be a good leader. She's outgoing, friendly.

Sean - I think she seems pretty strong as well. I'd be down for Sarah. That twist from Jeff makes things a little bit interesting

General - So what are you guys thinking about tonight's vote?

**Sarah** - Well, I personally have no qualms about being leader so if you think I'd be a good leader feel free to vote for me. I'll be an active participant in challenges and the tribe boards most of the time so I definitely think I could bring good qualities to that role.

Vecepia - I'm all for Sarah being leader.

General - I dont know what the leader really need to bring to this tribe! Its a tough call already Sean - I'd also be for Sarah being leader.

Gabriel - If Sarah wants it, i'll vote her! It doesn't matter to me. :)

Sean - Oh yea for sure. Should be interesting. Thats a long time to have immunity.

Sarah - Right. It'd be nice to have. Maybe i'll put myself out there for it.

Sean - I think that you'd be a great leader. You have my support.

Sarah - Awww thanks! That's really sweet of you. I'm sure there's a twist behind it but I mean, it can't be that bad, right?

Sean - It sure sounds too good to be true. But, hey if immunity is the good then you dont have much to worry about with the bad, at least until the merge.

General - I guess i'll see what other people thinks and i'll vote for the person that seems to want it the most

Sarah - I'm kind of indifferent about the whole thing. It's sort of scary to think there might be a negative twist to coincide with it but if no one else comes forward I won't be against it.

General - Vee already threw you to that role anyway! Haha So I think you might get it xd

Sarah - I mean it'd be nice but someone will probably come for it. It'd be nice but I doubt i'll get it.

General - Well I can vote for you if you want! Anyway you,re the nicest I talked to so far!

Sarah - Awe thanks! That's really sweet. I'm hoping there isn't some negative twist paired with it. I've been excited for this for a week so it'd be kind of upsetti

**General** - It proably have something bad. Who would give a free immunity? Maybe you're losing the right to vote at Tribal or something... Or switching tribe. I dont know....

Sarah - I'm all for any sort of twist as long as I'm not screwed over and given no chance in the same.

**CONFESSIONAL – Sarah -** General is saying the leader might receive some sort of punishment or some negative twist but I mean twists aren't designed to screw players over so how bad can it really be? I'll put myself out there for it but I mean I don't really expect to win it. It'd be nice, sure.

While the tribe seems to be settling on Sarah as the leader, more tribe members arrive and throw their hats into the ring.

**CONFESSIONAL – John** - My strategy just know is to make it appear like I want Tribe Leader but make sure someone else gets it. That way people know I'm here to play but the burden of leadership ain't on me! Also it might raise my sympathy meter a little bit, which never hurts. In terms of long term approach I really dont know, I'm just gonna roll with the punches and see what happens!

Sean - Hi John, Just wanted to say hello since we are on the same tribe :)

John - Hey man, how's it going, I'm kinda late to the party tonight but it wont happen again. Yeah good to be working with you bro, hopefully we'll be able to go out there and kick some ass!

Sean - sounds good man. Had a chance to read anything yet?

John - Yeah just got caught up on everything just now. I put myself forward for the tribe leader position, go big or go home in my opinion lol and I do really want the position and I think I will do it well. So yeah please think about throwing me a vote.

Sarah - Haven't heard anything from you so I wanted to say hi before Tribal. What are you thinking for the vote?

John - Hey Sarah, just wanted to touch base with you and tell you good luck in the game. Im looking forward to competing with you in the game. As for the tribe leader thing, i've put myself forward and do want the position but I know I cant vote for myself, so if I cant get it I want you to so my vote is going to you.

Sean - what are you thinking now that more then one people want it?

General - I'm still behind Sarah. First come first serve!

Sean - Thats what I'm thinking too. John seemed a little too eager to me:/

General - True he is!

# Mariche Cacique Council, Night 01

**Holly Hoffman - HOST -** Welcome Mariche, to your first Tribal Council! But don't worry, no one is leaving us tonight.

As you are aware there is a very big decision to be made, the election of your tribes leader, or Cacique as they will be known. The Caciques will be making some very important decisions for your tribe so choose wisely.

This is going to be a very casual affair, if the tribe is unanimous we can bypass the vote all together and announce the Cacique. If not, we will head for a vote which will be due by 10.30pm Eastern (9.30pm Central).

Sarah - I think I'm ready aside from the nerves that there could be a twist to it we're not being made aware of. I definitely hope I won't let my tribe down.

Peter - Yes I am, I would have been willing to take the position, but I think Sarah will do just as well as I would have. Hopefully this tribe will be unified regardless! Mariche strong.

Holly Hoffman - Well then I believe we have come to a decision without the need to take to votes.

Congratulations Sarah, you are the Cacique for the Mariche tribe.

**General** - Congrats Sarah:)

John - Congratulation Sarah!

Sarah - Yay! Thanks for this, guys! :)

Sean - Congrats Sarah! You'll do great!

Gabriel - You're the bomb, Sarah!

Jeff Probst - Sarah, i'll explain more of your duties as team leader in due time.

Everyone else, please meet me back here Sunday night at 8c/9e for your first Immunity Challenge!

Just as the tribe has made a unanimous and unified decision and Sarah is getting comfortable with her role as leader, the previous notion of a catch is about to come into play.

Jeff Probst - Congratulations Sarah!

You have earned Immunity until the merge by being proclaimed the Leader of your tribe.... As long as you wish to remain Cacique.

This is very important, you are not allowed to divulge what I'm about to tell you next. If you do, you will be immediately disqualified from the game.

In Stranded as in life, nothing comes cheap. You have gained the respect of your tribemates by becoming the tribe Leader, Cacique... And in return for Immunity, you're about to lose all respect that you have gained.

In order to keep Cacique status, you will have to complete a task each round. If you complete it to satisfaction, you will get to keep your Cacique status. If you do not, you must give away Cacique to someone else. You can at any time step down as Cacique... You cannot at any time reveal that you were completing these tasks.

No one can every know that you have been on missions, they must believe that you are 100% genuine in all your tasks and it will not be easy. With each task, you will alienate yourself from your tribe more and more... However, you also are given a free pass to the second half of the game. It's a trade off and

depending on how well you handle it, it could be a relatively easy ride there.

It's up to you now. And remember... What happens with Caciques, stays with Caciques.

Sarah - Oh my god. I'll try my hardest to keep the bridges burned to an absolute minimum.

Sarah – CONFESSIONAL - Alright, day one and I'm the leader of the tribe. By being the leader, I need to complete a task every round which will put me in a predicament at the merge. These tasks are supposedly designed to pit me against my tribe and I won't lie, it's definitely a frightening task. I'm not sure how well i'll be able to keep it a secret and how well I can complete the tasks without making my tribe hate me. I'm not a quitter, I don't want to be the person who quit the second a bump came along the road. I want to be the chameleon, I want to adapt to this little hitch and take it in stride. These tasks won't define my game, I won't let them.

**Big Tom** - As long as i can learn the format quickly, and my tribe pulls itself together, I'm fairly confident I can win

**Diane** - My strategy is to play nobly. I want to make friends and play the game with them. I am here to win of course, but I find that playing the game can be just as fun. And I want to play this game with people I like, not people who are annoying

Sean - Awesome! I was thinking him too. Maybe V as well?

Sarah - Yeah, Vecepia seems great.

**Sarah** - So, I really like you. I wanted to approach you and see how you feel about working together. I know Sean is trying to form something and I've asked him to include you but I definitely want to work with you either exclusively or as part of that. :) Let me know what you think.

Gabriel - This is amazing! I was really hoping to work with you but I was a tad nervous to initiate it. Sean asked me to work with him and now I see why. It's be really cool if us three could form a trio, but I'd definitely keep you in the top spot. So it's sort of exclusive, but we'll still be with Sean. This is great great news.

Sarah - That's fantastic because I really like you!

Gabriel - It's mutual! This is a good night!

Just as the members of the tribe are settling in and making plans for the future, the two latecomers stir things up with their arrival.

Patricia - The Tardy Two. That's us: P but hopefully they'll get past that. It's a pleasure to meet you Gina! I'm looking forward to many a good chat with you:)

**Gina** - Well if that isn't a great alliance name I don't know what is. Awfully excited for this game to start! What do you think about this leader format? I'm honestly kinda nervous, since they get immunity until the merge. That seems like an awful lot of power.

Patricia - Oh thank jeebus you want to talk game straight up :P It's so nerve wracking bringing up things like that early on :P especially when you're late. Not that there's anything wrong with chit-chat :)This game ought to be really good, especially with this Cacique twist. it IS a lot of power but come the merge there's no bigger target. Sarah seems well liked so I suppose everyone will just cozy up to her and she'll pick and choose who she wants to work with though. But as long as we're friendly, amiable, and don't suck in challenge I hope we don't have anything to worry about.

Gina - Hah, I'm down to be your sanity rock if you'll be mine. I haven't really talked game with anyone else; like you, it's just been 'rah rah our tribe is great' sort of stuff. I completely agree, but I think the tone will shift when we lose a challenge. That's when we'll really get to know people. And yeah, Sarah's vote will be a powerful one. It doesn't actually really mean too much more, but I think the perception of her as a power player will send a lot of people gravitating towards her. Whether or not it's true is up for debate-but perception is reality.

**Gina – CONFESSIONAL** - Patricia's the only one that's really opened up to me. I have no choice at this point but to trust her. I mean, I'll still vote her out if I have to. But I'll feel a little bad. I'm also wary about the three that volunteered to be leaders. Who was it, Sarah, John and Peter? Those are all people to watch out for. Obviously Sarah is immune until the merge, but I'll be keeping my eye on John and Peter.

# Tamanaco, Night 01

Diane and Big Tom are quickly becoming friends and are trying to expand upon that.

Big Tom - i havent barley talked to anyone yet, just a few people making small talk, how about you? Diane - Lol, same. Still trying to formulate a strategy. I think right now I'm more into getting to know everyone.

Big Tom - That seems pretty important, especially how early it is in the game, i wouldnt mind us sticking together though, a pair can be very powerful you know

Diane - Lol that's funny, I was going to ask you the same thing. I figured as the elders of this tribe, if you, me, and MamaKim stick together we can have a solid final three alliance!

Big Tom - That is true! have you talked to mamakim yet? i havent gotten around to it

Diane - Yep! I'm messaging her right now, already mentioned us as a final 3 to her. She seems really nice, so hopefully she'll be up for it!

Diane - Hey! How's it going Kim J! Congrats on being the Cacique! I sent you a PM a few minutes ago but I don't think it got sent, so hopefully this one goes through lol

So how do you feel about being the Cacique right now?

Kim J - No worries! To be completely honest, I didn't plan on being leader for this tribe. I walked into this game with a completely different strategy in mind. Although, it seems to be a very welcomed position, so I can't exactly complain xD

Diane - So what was your strategy that you had in mind if you don't mind my asking? I'll be honest with you, as the two older females of the tribe I think we would make a good team. I'm excited to get to know everyone early on, but I think it's good to establish at least one alliance as early as possible. I didn't step

up to be the tribe leader because I don't feel I'm a good leader, but I know that I can be an extremely helpful number 2! I bet you're glad you stepped up now since you have immunity until merge lol.

Kim J - Lmao xD. I wen't out drinking and eating with the family so it may be the booze talking, but I honestly didn't have any plans to being the tribe leader. I just flapped my big mouth and here I am.I deffinately have a day-by-day strategy working for me, so a duo alliance sounds great!

Diane - I think that would be an excellent option for both of us! I'm talking to Big Tom about it since we're the 3 elders. I think if we trust each other and stick together we can have a solid final 3 alliance. What do you think?

Kim J - I'm digging that for sure. And sounds good, Big Tom definitely sounded like he knew what he was talking about.

**Diane – CONFESSIONAL** - I'm feeling pretty confidant right now. The first thing I wanted to do was to lobby for a good strong alliance. Mama Kim was my first go to, and luckily she ended up being our Cacique, so that definitely helps! :)The two of us have already signed on for a final 2 alliance and taking each other to the end, so hopefully that will pay off. I trust her completely and don't believe she'll play me. And I also think that she's a smart player who I can work with. I have no intention of stabbing her in the back or using her to my advantage, and I trust that she feels the same. I think I'm going to be her go-to for advice if she runs into trouble and I'm all for lending a hand.

After the Cacique vote, there are plenty of congratulations thrown Kim's way, but it's one in particular that begins the shape the future of Tamanco.

Kim J - Frank and the Kim's XD sounds fine with me. She deffinately was intelligent while talking in the discussion. We'll be a strong group.

Frank - She brought in Linda and Lindsey so we can have 5 strong. Tribe of 9 so we're good until merge. Let's just get there with numbers. Kim P assures me that its the 3 of us who are core, and I do believe her. You're my number one alliance though, you seem like a smart player.

Kim J - Thanks! To be honest, I feel most connected to you as well. I'm not exactly sure if bringing people in left and right without discussing it is a bright idea, so hopefully Kim P has the group in mind when bringing in Linda and Lindsay. If were at five, then theres no real worries untill merge. So long as everyone keeps there word. I don't see a reason why any of them would lie this early. Could I still talk to others to see where everyone's heads are at?

Frank - Definitely try to get the others talking. The more we know the better. Kim P just kinda dropped that on me that she has Linda and Lindsey so I didn't have much influence in that. Although, it is a good thing that we have a solid 5. I think we should stick with them until further information is revealed. Do you think its a good idea to get an "alliance" group message started?

Kim J - Definitely. If you could set it up, that would be great. To be completely honest, I don't exactly trust Linda all that much. Apparently she's sending out group mails left and right. First opinions can change though, and she's already making up for it with humor.

Frank - I know of Linda and Diane to send mass messages getting to know people. I don't necessarily hold that against them as they don't seem to all offer alliances but I am aware they are here to play. Diane seems a bit clueless or she is playing clueless.

Kim J - I'm talking to her and have been invited to an alliance with her and Big Tom. Please don't tell anyone else in our alliance for now. First night, I wan't to see if they're trustworthy down the road before I trust information with them. But mainly, it sounds as if Diane is trying to herd Tom and I into a team. I don't mind it, of course;) And I mean it, I think the two of us could have a long lasting alliance. I like the others, but this is a Final 3 game after all. Plus, it seems like they are a group, the 3 of them. Listen to this - So far, we can get out Clarence, followed by Lex. At that point, we can choose. Either Kim P and her crew or Diane and Tom. We should see who we like more. Either way, we'll be in majority.

Frank - That's good, me and you need to keep our options open. I won't divulge anything about that to the rest of our alliance. I think we should see the options, vote out the ones that don't give us options but build up our 5 man alliance.

Kim J - True, true. I don't want to be led to the slaughterhouse by Kim and her 3 though. I don't know who she's more loyal to.

With this new information, Frank becomes suspicious of Diane and begins turning the tides against her.

Frank - Big Tom is the only one I haven't talked with either. I don't understand why he is making such an obvious mistake. Does he think he has numbers without us? I can't tell for sure but I'm guessing Diane, Lex and Tom are a possible trio.

Lindsey - Hm, why do you think Lex/Diane/Tom are together?

Frank - Mainly cause Tom and Lex aren't bothering much to snoop around. Diane seems smart enough to have a plan, yet she didn't really make me any offers. They are outside this 5 so its a fair chance to assume they have some sort of alliance forming. My guess is Diane is gonna try and get two of us to flip, or one + Clarence. At the moment she seems like she is "investigating" the situation.

Lindsey - Those are some good points. I talked to Lex and he seems pretty cool. I don't doubt that's the case. Diane has been messaging me and just sent me a weird message asking if I've "gotten around to everyone." Stay tuned. I might be the one she approaches.

Frank - I think Diane sent that exact message to everyone, trying to fish for information. I don't particularly get a good vibe from her to be honest lol.

Lindsey - Omg neither do I AT ALL. Idk why but something about her being so talkative when we were electing our leader put me off and now all this blatant scheming is kinda alienating me haha. I know this is premature but if I had to choose one person to vote off right now... Well, I think you know what I'm getting at.

Frank - Yea i know, I feel the same way. When i bounced back to her the whole "Are you getting to know everyone" question, she said she is worried about people flipping at the merge and not being able to Pagong the other tribe. I was like, wait to get to the merge first maybe? It just seemed weird. And the mass identical message really sealed the deal, I mean, at least bother to say something to me like a person not a spam bot.

Lindsey - Yeah, that's so true. Blah it kinda bugs me when people think that far ahead. It feels very presumptuous and kinda cocky imo. It's offputting. She's trying really hard to get me to talk to Tom and something about it feels off to me.

Lindsey – CONFESSIONAL - I may like the people in my alliance but I'm always willing to change things up. This is an online game. There's nothing at stake here with a win except pride and bragging rights, so I'd much rather be memorable than win honestly. If I can do both? Well, that's just a plus. Mama Kim actually kind of scares me already. She seems like an extremely strong player in all aspects. Plus it says a lot that she was the first one to step up to take the lead. The other 3 were together before we came in and Linda just seems very genuine and like she'll be true to me over anyone else.

Frank - To get the discussion started, what do you guys think the other 4 tribe members plans are at this stage? I see Diane trying very hard to fish for information, even sending out a copy pasted message to, I assume, everyone. Tom is a mystery, Lex wasn't online much and Clarence was kinda late to the party.

Kim P - I feel like Diane and Clarence are kinda desperate to be in an alliance of some sort so it would probably be smart to eliminate the ones who aren't even trying to fit in like Tom and Lex. What do you guys think?

Frank - I do smell the desperation in Diane as well. I think we should hold off the decision on who to eliminate out of them four until we actually lost a challenge. Whoever we do eliminate we have to make

the others that will be left come merge feel safe, so if any one of you has the chance to make a fake alliance to include them, I'd encourage them to do it. But keep our alliance informed at all times.

Kim P - Exactly. Diane's desperation could pay off if we needed her vote. This is getting ridiculous. Look what Diane sent me. LIL KIM!!! LolWhat's up? :) Tell me something about yourself! I really want to get to know everybody. You seem like an honest person. Who would you kick off first if you had the choice? Frank - She has the social awareness of a concrete brick. Now she's trying some small talk with me.

# Mariche, Day 02

Sarah - Hey John. Just wanted to say hi. I'm thinking maybe we could start something in the game forum to build tribe morale and keep activity up. Do you have any ideas of stuff we could do?

John - Hey Sarah, Yeah I dono, maybe just a getting to know you thread, somewhere were we can tell each other what our favorite movies, music etc? I know that sounds simple but sometimes the simplest things create bonds lol

Sarah - Hmm... Something like that might work. Anyway, how are you?

John - I'm doing pretty good thanks. You? I feel like this might be a good time to talk a little bit of game but I don't want to come on to strong too soon lol. But hey I guess you only really play once right, So what you thinking just now you got any good feelings/bad feelings about anyone, or have any idea where the game is going anytime soon? I've touched base with everyone but so far with the exception of you I havent really had much interaction with that many people

Sarah - I'm great. I'm really glad to have gotten a good night's sleep. And no, I totally agree. I don't think it's ever too soon to really talk game, I think. I really like the tribe so far, no one has really said or done anything to make me think ill of them yet. How about for you? I've talked to most of the tribe and everyone seems pretty cool.

John - Yeah no one has said or done anything that I think is suspect and the tribe is looking pretty good. I hate to use a cliche Survivor term but I think it might not be a bad idea to firm up a kind of "core four" within the tribe. That way if things start to go wrong and we start loosing you and I can at least stay safe along with a couple of others. The only person I've spoken to, apart from yourself, that I really feel is trust worthy is Gabriel. Him and I have only exchanged a couple of messages but he seems like a pretty decent and solid guy. Is there anyone else that you think would be good to have on board a core four alliance?

Sarah - Yeah, I really like Gabriel and that idea. Maybe you could try and bring in Patricia as well? I like Patricia.

John - Yeah, Me, You, Gabe and Pat, if you like the sound of that I'll propose the plan to the two of them and see if we cant get the ball rolling. Hopefully we wont need to worry about anything for a while but I know I'll feel better knowing that we have numbers if something goes wrong.

Sarah - Yeah, that'd be fantastic.

**John – CONFESSIONAL** - Right now I'm in the middle of implementing a "core four" alliance with Me, Sarah, Gabe and Pat. My plan was to propose a core four alliance to Sarah, suggest Gabe as a third member and let Sarah pick the fourth. The reason for this is I trust Gabe, I don't know why, I just do. I was hoping that Sarah would propose the General as the fourth member, meaning that I could keep my two biggest perceived threats closest. Alas she did not she proposed Pat and I had to run with it.

John wastes no time in trying to form his 'core four.'

Like you say, let's hope it doesn't come down to it for a long time but I'm excited about this group of 4:) Of course, it's not a majority, but I'm sure with Sarah's leadership it won't be hard to convince the couple of extra votes when we need them.

While agreeing to the alliance, Patricia wastes no time in ratting John out to her tardy friend, Gina.

Patricia - Well things are already paying off in spades 😈 John just messaged me on behalf of Sarah saying that the both of them would like to set up a little kind of deal between them, me and Gabriel. They haven't talked targets yet but I'm sure it'll come up, and you'll be the first person I tell, but even though they didn't include you this could be a good thing. They've only got 4 at the moment, which isn't even a majority so they'll clearly have to talk to one of you, General, Sean, Vee or Peter at some point. If I give you information from the inside, and you can tell me what they're telling the people on the 'outside', then you and I will have all the information and can maneuver as we please 🥰

Gina - Vee and Peter have thus far been fairly elusive to me, but I am fairly friendly with the General. It'll be harder to bring together Peter, Vee and Sean for some sort of alliance just because they seem to not be on as much. Although it is just the second day, that could change. Honestly though, I think you, me and Gabe could have a pretty good little sub-alliance if I could worm my way into that main group.

Patricia - You need to get out of my head! I was literally just confessionaling like "It would be nice if Gabe, Gina and I could hook up on the side". Damn girl.

Gina - I'd say you're in a position to make that happen! I mean, as someone in that alliance, you could try and bring me in. Haven't talked much to John, but Gabe, Sarah and I are friendly enough. It would put us all in a good spot for a few rounds at least (barring any huge shakeups).

Gabriel - So if we were to go to tribal council, you would rather vote with Patricia and John than General, Sean, and Vee? Also, I never know whether to call General THE General or just General in general. 😽 Sarah - That's not what I'm saying.

Gabriel - What are you saying? I'm up for whatever you want! Just trying to get an understanding of what's going on.

Sarah - I think it's a little too early to decide which alliance we'll side with for the entire game.

Gabriel - Fair enough! Just know that I want to stick with you over everyone else.



Just as John tries to form a separate 4 person alliance (which Patricia shares with Gina), the other alliance of 5 that Gabriel and Sarah are apart of is beginning to talk turkey.

**General** - I guess you saw the message (by Sean) of the alliance with Sean, Sarah Gabe and I. What do you think about that?

**Vecepia** - I'm all for the alliance. You guys all seem like genuine trustworthy people.

**General** - Cool any target if we lose the first IC?

**Vecepia** - I think all of us as an alliance of 5 will have to make that decision together. I'm unsure of who it would be. It's gonna be tough to decide.

General - I agree! We should take out the weaker one!

**Vecepia** - Just trying to get the collective thoughts on the alliance here: Who do you think we should vote out if we lose the immunity challenge?

**Gabriel** - My first thought is Peter. But it's only because I've talked to him the least. What do you think? **Vecepia** - I like John and he seems knowledgeable so I don't feel like he should be voted out first. Patricia seems like she knows about the challenges well. I guess it's between Peter or Gina?

Gabriel - I think so too. It'll be more obvious if we lose the challenge I think.

From posting the same thing 5 times to being socially awkward, Peter's name is in every discussion around Mariche.

**Gabriel** - My first instinct is to say Peter, because I've talked to him the least. But it's not too big of a deal to me. Who are you thinking?

General - Yeah he seems kinda out of the loop so far! I dont know who to target!

Gabriel - Well, I think that we shouldn't rush ourselves! Let's focus on winning first and then we can target properly.

**General** - So What do you think of our tribe/tribe mates?

**Gina** - I'd say this is a good group. I really like Gabe and you, and I think Sarah is going to be a great leader. How about you? And- There are a few people I haven't communicated much with- particularly Vee, Sean, Peter and John. Have you been able to communicate much with them?

General - I've been talking to everybody but some are more talkative then other. I agree that Vee and Peter aren't really talkative. Both just answer like in one line without asking any question. Its kinda weird Gina - Yeah, it's hard to have a dialogue going when the person on the other end is a person of few words. Hopefully they'll open up soon. General - Yeah. He doesn't speak much privatly to me much too lol

Sean - Thinking either Gina or peter as neither of them have really talked and Peter has that posting problem. :P

General - Yeah Peter is just weird. He isnt that talkative with anyone I think! He seems like not as active as the rest of the tribe.

#### Tamanaco, Day 02

Big Tom - Im wary of Linda, it seems like she is talking final 3 with a few people, and playing unhonestly Diane - Oh is she? How do you know?

Big Tom - After the tribal, everyone was basically messgaing around and saying hi and making small talk, and a few mentioned that linda had messaged them, one or two said she was talking strategy with them

Diane - Interesting, she never talked strategy with me. I guess I'm not in her plans for final 3 LOL, glad that you, Mama Kim and me have a final 3 already set up. Hopefully we won't have to worry about her for a while. But in case we do, are you thinking she should be first to go? Do you know who she had been talking to about making a final 3??

Meanwhile, as Diane and Big Tom theorize over who may be making alliances, Diane and Kim J receive yet another alliance offer.

Diane - Hey Clarence! Hope you're doing ok this evening. So what made you drawn to Mama Kim and me to make an alliance with us over everyone else?

Clarence - I thought that you two would make great alliance partners because you were so welcoming to me above everyone else and Mama Kim was nice as well and seems to have everyone's support! Less chance of getting blindsided when you're secretly tight with two super popular tribe members who everyone will probably come to with voting ideas x'D!

Diane - Oh awesome! That makes me glad that we could make you feel welcome. I don't think you'll have to worry about being the odd man out anymore. Lex has hardly been seen by anyone!

Diane - Hey sorry I haven't replied. Been a long busy day! It seems like we have another three person alliance to worry about. Tom said it looks like Frank Linda and Kim P.

Kim J - Looks like you were right about Frank. How'd he find out?

Diane - Not sure, but that's what I was thinking before he even said it based on their interactions with me.

**Diane – CONFESSIONAL** - My closest ally, Mama Kim, has said that she's been talking to Frank and that she's really getting to know him. That kind of scares me because it's my closest ally and my biggest "?" talking to each other. I could be totally wrong by listening to Tom, and Frank could actually be completely trustworthy! Hopefully Mama Kim is establishing a good relationship with Frank so that he's not a problem later.

As Kim J is keeping tabs on all aspects of the tribe, the news that Big Tom may have found out about the other alliance is cause for alarm. She immediately informs frank that their secret alliance may not be a secret.

Kim J - Diane found out - somewhat. She told me that she found out you/Linda/Kim P are in an alliance. She says Tom told her. I'd keep an eye out for Lindsey. I couldn't exactly defend you, I just told her that it's logical to pursue you three. If she asks, I'll ask to get rid of Kim P before you, just in case she has the numbers. Be careful who you tell. Someone in our group ousted the information.

Frank - That does raise an eyebrow. It's a bit of a weird combination me linda and Kim P. From what I know Lindsey and Linda are a pair. Maybe Lindsey blabbed something to Tom to get his trust. Let's see if anyone in our group says something. I wouldn't push to find out who dun it, For all we know Diane is bluffing and just made a guess, same way we guess she has Lex and Clarence.

Kim J - That's a very good point, although I think she legitimately could have Clarence with her. She said she's going to talk to Lindsey tomorrow to get her with the "majority". And your right, she could be making it up. I talked her into voting out Linda, and she was easily swayed. Maybe she's just happy that I care enough to throw in my opinion. Frank - I think that if we have to vote, Diane should go first. I see no way we could work with her in the future and no way she doesn't flip if shes around at the merge. She's creating too much commotion and she should just..go.

Kim J – CONFESSIONAL - Immediately, Frank and I set up a deal to go to the end. At first, with Kim P. Kim P then brought in Lindsey and Linda almost immediately, which I am slightly worried about. I'm thinking the three of them possibly have a deal going. I've talked to Frank about it, but he seems comfortable with it till merge. Understandable I guess - he's preparing himself for merge. I've been promised merge. Then Diane set up a deal with me, and we're chatting up and such. As time progresses, Diane seems to have talked to EVERYONE, and is rubbing people the wrong way. Me? Not so much. I actually kind of like her. But the enemy of my friend is my enemy, so I'm going to jump on the bandwagon against her. She and I have set up two final three's - one with Big T, the other with Clarence.

With Frank on the offensive, it doesn't take long for the tides to turn against Diane.

Frank - As you know Kim J is a bit infiltrated with Diane and she heard Tom told Diane that Me, you and Linda are in an alliance. Bit odd that just the 3 of us. She might be bluffing or guessing, but thought you should know. I don't see any reason to doubt Lindsey and Linda so far, i think they are safely locked with us. What do ya think Diane is doing?

Kim P - That is interesting. I don't know why she would assume us three. She probably is just bluffing. I haven't found a reason to not trust Linda yet. Whatever but Diana is seriously annoying me.

Frank - Yeah, I'd definitely get her out first if we lose tomorrow.

Linda - She is getting kind of annoying. I think she can be sweet deep down but it's wrapped up in obnoxious paranoia. She was actually telling me about how she's always "careful to find a middle ground between not asking at all and not coming on too strong about what people want to do"

### Mariche, Day 04

Vecepia - Yeah, I'm in the same situation as you. BTW sorry for sending you this message 3 times, I thought my inbox was broke.

John - haha yeah no worries. And if I hear your name being floated about I'll be sure to let you know Vecepia - Same for me.

Sean addresses the entire alliance: Sean, Vecepia, Sarah, General and Gabriel.

Sean - Hey Guys, I just wanted to let you know that I sadly wont be at the challenge tomorrow night due to work: (but I know you guys will kill it. Just in case we lost I sent in a pre vote for Peter. Dont feel like you guys have to vote for him, but I thought he was a safe bet. Goodluck!

**Gabriel** - Yeah, we're definitely gonna kill it. Just make sure you let one of the hosts know! **General** - Fair enough.. He's awfully silent with me so i'm good with that

# Immunity Challenge, Day 04

Before the challenge, Jeff Probst approaches each of the Cacique's with their first mission in order to keep Cacique status.

**Jeff Probst - Host -** For tonight's mission, should you choose to accept it, you will be sabotaging tonight's challenge for your tribe.

### Cacique Mission #1 - Saboteur

Tonight's challenge will run in stages. As the leader of the tribe, you will of course have the last and most important stage. You are not allowed to reveal to your tribe what the challenge is before hand, nor can you hint at what they should prepare for. Here's where your sabotage comes in. You must wait 45 minutes after your tribe has completed the puzzle before you are allowed to repost the completed puzzle in the challenge thread. Please note that both tribes' Caciques will have this mission and if your tribe finishes their puzzle first, you should be able to win given that you post it 45 minutes after they do. Do you completely and fully understand your mission and are you prepared to complete it?

**Sarah** - Alright, I understand. I think I can do this without upsetting anyone. Kim J - Alright, thanks. I feel so bad P:

Sarah – CONFESSIONAL - It's definitely possible these tasks will bring out 'Evil Sarah' because as hard as I try to control the part of me that is outwardly bitchy and manipulative, I tend to fail at it. I don't want to be the villain, I've never wanted to be the bad guy but at the same time I've never considered myself a hero. I don't tend to think of anyone but myself in this. I don't care if they dislike me, I probably dislike them a well, but I really do care about my personal game too much to screw myself over by being the bitch.

Jeff Probst – HOST - Welcome Everyone. Here's how today's challenge will work.

I will post 25 puzzle pieces. They will be images so you will need to know how to post them as I'm sure you've been practicing. The first tribe to post their correctly completed 5x5 puzzle in this thread wins Immunity.

Now, to make this more fun, we've divided the duties into 3 parts. The first round will be posting your puzzle pieces in your tribal discussion thread. 3 different tribe members will be in control of this portion of the challenge. They must post repost each individual puzzle piece in its own post in your tribal discussion forum.

The second round will be actually reassembling the puzzle. This must be done using the original image codes ( [img]....jpg[/ img] ) The final round will be completed by your tribe leaders only. They must repost the completed puzzle in this thread. The first tribe to do so wins Immunity.

Are we all clear?

Peter - What happens if our leader isn't present?

Linda - You get voted out :P

**Jeff Probst** – **Host** - If the leader isn't present, then the tribe is shit out of luck. When we asked you to vote for the leader, we wanted you to pick the most reliable tribe mate you had. Now you know why.

The challenge begins and right out of the gate the puzzle posters are off and running. On Tamanaco, Linda and Lindsey make quick work of posting the puzzle pieces for their tribe. Kim P is struggling.

Kim J - Who got the other pieces?

Frank - working on it, might take a minute, there are quite a few pieces

Lindsey - Omg where is Kim P

Linda - Frank do as much as you can. Hopefully Kim P shows up again..

Kim J - I thought 3 people got pieces. Thanks for competing guys. Frank, when your done, post the last picture in here

Kim P - Sorry guys my parents were being bitches. Posting them now.

After the delay, Kim P continues posting the rest of the pieces and Tamanaco begins solving their puzzle. On Mariche, the tribe is reeling even before their puzzle posters begin posting pieces. Sarah has announced to the tribe that she cannot make the challenge because of a very important affair.

Sarah - sorry guys. i'm not going to be able to make it for a while. going swimming. sorry.

Peter - Well as Jeff put it.. We are shit out of luck. Sarah isn't here am I right?

General - You are right. We lost except if Sarah appears

Peter - PLEASE COME BACK FROM SWIMMING SARAH. PLEASE.

**Sarah** - alright, i came back to see the challenge.

Vecepia - Thank God.

Gabriel - Sarah, you HAVE to be here for us to win.

Sarah - I'll try to be back as soon as I can. I'm not at my house right now and I'm about to leave.

Gabriel - Oh my gosh. Can you get on your phone at all? It'll just take a copy and paste from you.

Despite their leader's absence, the tribe continues to solve the puzzle as best they can and one of them uses some unconventional methods.





**Gabriel** 

Peter posts the images of his computer screen to show the tribe that he is completing it on his desktop. Meanwhile on the other tribe, Frank has just completed the puzzle and the tribe is celebrating unaware that Kim J now has to wait 45 minutes before she can post the completed puzzle.



Frank - Kim P - Amazing Frank!

Diane - Good job!!

Linda - Kim J are you here?

Big Tom - So now Kim has to repost right

Diane - Frank, can't you just copy and paste your whole post into a PM for Kim?

Kim J - Guys, i'm having a slight family emergency. I'm so sorry. I'll be on my phone to post. I'm really,

really sorry. It should work on my phone if I copy paste

Diane - It's ok, no worries, family comes first! Just do your best!

Frank - Quick Kim J quote my previous post to Probst!!!!

Lindsey - GO KIM J GO <3 Frank you are an angel

Big Tom - Go kimmey go! :D

Frank - the suspense in killing me, Kim???

Linda - MAMA KIM YOU GOT THIS!

10 minutes later, Gabriel on the Mariche tribe has assembled their puzzle and are also unaware that they now have to wait 45 minutes before Sarah is allowed to post the completed puzzle.

**Gabriel – CONFESSIONAL** - I am so fucking pissed right now. Like, what the heck! IT'S NOT THAT HARD. JUST COPY AND PASTE FROM YOUR PHONE. OH MY GOD.

Gabriel - SARAH! QUOTE THAT POST! And post it here: viewtopic.php?f=11&t=96&start=20

Gabriel - This is so intense. I just hope Sarah gets on soon. I sent her a PM back at camp.

**Vecepia -** Nice job. Lol I just realized how to make it into a puzzle and was like 2 rows done. It would suck if she doesn't get here in time!

Peter - She just needs to copy that quote and post it to the original challenge post and we win??


Gabriel - Exactly... and she's online at the moment :D -waves Sarah down!-

John - Good work guys, sorry I couldn't be more help with putting the puzzle together!

Peter - Hopefully Sarah will be here soon.. And I hope my picture helped a bit. Great job tribe!

**Kim J – CONFESSIONAL** - 20 minutes. If you have anything to quell my boredom, I'm open.

After the 45 minutes are up, the Cacique posts the final completed puzzle.



Kim J - That's it! We're done? We good here?

Gabriel - ....

**Jeff Probst** - Congratulations Tamanaco, you have won the first Tribal Immunity Challenge. You can go back and celebrate tomorrow. Mariche, unfortunately, you guys failed so solve the puzzle in time, and I will see you at tribal Council tomorrow at 8c/9e.

Lindsey - OH MY GOSH I'M DEAD. Love you all. <3

Gabriel - Yeah, right, we failed to solve the puzzle! We had it done ages before they posted it. : ( Sad times.

Kim P - YAY! GREAT TEAMWORK EVERYBODY!!!!

Frank - I'm sorry for your leader being absent but ours has been complete for over an hour as well. :P Thankfully our leader came through and saved the day!

Sarah - Oh my God guys! I am so sorry. I just got back.

General – CONFESSIONAL - Thanks but no thanks Sarah... I hope swimming was fun ... T\_T

**Sarah – CONFESSIONAL** - I hate feeling like I'm letting them down and that's very hard. They just lost the challenge because I wanted immunity. I'm going to keep fighting for the immunity but I don't like feeling like they hate me. I can handle it but I do feel bad because I feel like eventually a task will come along that is incredibly hard to complete and this will all be for nothing.

### Tamanaco, Night 04

After their first Immunity win, all seems to have been forgiven about Kim J's 45 minute delay. The alliance of 5: Linda, Lindsey, Kim J, Frank and Kim P have gone from confident to arrogant as they celebrate.

Kim J – CONFESSIONAL - Going forward, these Cacique missions (so far) have perfectly been made to get me to lie to my tribe mates and try to sabotage them for personal immunity. My main worry is that the missions will cause me to detach from my alliance. These missions are a tad stressful, as I have to play "ground control" to clear my name afterwards. I created a lie about the last challenge, and I'm unsure if I can keep on crafting lies to protect my Cacique title. It's still very fun, I just had a few moments of worry. Especially minutes before I submitted my post. I was scared that the other tribe would submit their post and I would just look like I lost the game. I can't imagine what Sarah is going through.

Linda - So I think tonight means we will send Lex home for being inactive when the time comes? Lindsey - That's kinda what I was thinking too. I'm shocked how well we all worked on this challenge! Frank, you kicked ass, seriously.

Frank - Thanks guys. Well yea, if we have to vote someone I think Lex takes priority because he basically isn't even participating. I doubt we will get to Tribal any time soon though, the other tribe's leader wasn't

Linda - Gabriel needs to stop whining. I don't like him

Kim P - You all did great! So if we had lost would we have booted Lex?

Lindsey - The only one outside this group I've really talked to is Diane. She won't leave me alone tbh Kim J - I still make my rounds with Diane, Clarence, and occasionally Big Tom. I'm gonna try to talk to Clarence a bit more though, starting tonight. Of all of them, I think I can persuade Clarence to flip. He seems very wishy-washy. That might be bad for merge, though.

Kim P - Diane won't leave me alone either. Clarence and I have exchanged a few friendly words. Lex and

Tom haven't reached out at all so, naturally, I have no desire to talk to them. 🕌

Frank - I haven't heard from outside our alliance, they haven't tried to contact me for anything. I guess they are pretty sure I am allied with some of you and won't flip. How many of you they know about, I don't know. They seem to not have snooped out that Mama Kim is with us.

Linda - I don't think Diane leaves anyone alone

Kim P - Yeah, its Stalker 101 when it comes to Diane



Kim J - I feel bad for her. She tries so hard, yet she's blissfully unaware that all her effort is eventually for nothing.

Kim P - I know! She is so nice but also so rolls eyes If I had to pick our 6th person it would be Clarence. Kim J - I have an idea, how about I talk to Diane and tell her that Lex is with you guys. That way, she's not as inclined so keep him safe and voting him out won't ruffle any feathers. The longer we keep every Tamanaco tied down, the better. No matter how many of our people make merge, we could still lose if they feel un-included.

Kim P - Honestly are we sure we don't want Diane out first? I mean yes Lex wasn't even online, but from what I saw Diane didn't contribute anything except a few words of encouragement. And likely the other three would be blind without their leader and come crawling to us.

Meanwhile, as the Big Five are making fun of Diane's naivety, Clarence proposes an alliance of Diane and Mama Kim.

Clarence - Mama Kim!! Tonight revealed so many things about the tribe! So many people subtly complaining lol.Lex is an easy boot. Tom screwed up in the beginning and went all over the place. lol just like a Big Tom would. Kim P took forever in round one lol. And the tribe, based on their reactions about the other teams leader, seem ready to pounce on you if we ever do go to tribal council! They were so aggro.My thoughts, the easy first boot that everyone will push for when we go to tribal in the future will be Lex. I think that's a bad idea for you, me, and Diane, but great for everyone else.

Kim J - Very good points. I'm more worried if we fail to vote out Lex, then they might know we're a team and could pick us off. More-so, If we DO succeed in voting out someone other then Lex, the remaining people might retaliate at a tribe swap/merge. We got to keep the people calm for as long as possible, untill they can't do anything about the votes. Thoughts?

Diane - Great points, but like Mama Kim said, they would easily see that we were a team. Also, Frank was pretty good in the challenge tonight, and keeping him around for future challenges would be beneficial to us. Also, Clarence, you do know that Mama Kim has immunity until the merge right?

Clarence - So true!! We'll see how it goes this week! =D

Kim J - CONFESSIONAL - I like, but others don't. She would easily be my first-pick ally if she wasn't on the bottom of the totem pole. It's painful talking to her sometimes, because she doesn't even know that she's so disliked by certain people - namely, Kim P, Frank, and Lindsey. Still, Survivor is a group-dynamic kind of game. And if the group dislikes her, who am I to disagree?

Mama Kim exploits this information by using it for the Big Five's gain, but is beginning to struggle with outwardly lying to Diane.

Kim J - Literally just 10 seconds ago, Clarence sent me and Diane a massive mail entailing his opinions of the tribe and such. If he's sharing this information with Diane, then no-doubt she's his closest ally. Heres the cool part: He's also sharing this information with me. I think it might be better for me to do some talking, as it seems that he is fairly open to me. Also, if I mess up, I'm immune. If I take the fall, nothing happens. I might as well embrace my immunity.

Linda - You are definitely the opening Kim J. Milk this. Because your immunity grants you such power here. I am curious as to what they have said ©

Kim J - I'd feel kind of dirty posting it in here, but I can if you guys wan't. It's just his opinion on who did what at the challenge, and who to vote out.

Frank - Well now you made us curious Kim. Share the info It is interesting that Clarence confides in you. What if I suggest him a secret alliance and tell him that say, Linda, is my other key ally, then see if he shares that info with you? I don't think that has an downsides.

**Frank – CONFESSIONAL** - Diane got on everyone's nerves as she is basically scrambling on day one. Some people see her as a threat, I don't. She has the social ability of a concrete brick. Lex seems absent, Tom seems in Diane's pocket and Clarence is a wildcard.

Mama Kim then reposts the message Clarence sent to her.

Frank - Haha that's good, he's so out of the realm of what is happening. First of all, did he not get the memo that the tribe leader has immunity? If he thinks we'd wanna get you out, that's brilliant, that means they are sure you are with them.

Lindsey - Oh my gosh <a></a> <3 that was beautiful. You have Clarence hook, line & sinker. Gj Mama Kim love you boo They are right tho, I was quite aggro. But I would never jump on you like that. I'm just promoting tribe spirit in the best way possible: shit talking the other tribe lol <a><a><a><a></a> Well, you guys were right. My patience (aka half an hour of waiting LOL) paid off! Diane sent me a PM titled "Strategy" where she said that she wanted to talk strategy and alliances with me because "It seems like some people have already started talking alliances within the tribe." I'mma play dumb and worm my way into her <3

Without missing a beat, Frank uses this new information to his advantage and makes a move outside of the Big Five alliance.

Frank - Remember how I told you on Day One I'd watch your back if you watch mine? I'm cool with us not being openly allied and just having a secret alliance of sorts. No matter how numbers fall if we do have to vote, lets make sure both of us make the merge so we can work together then? I have Linda for 100% sure but I'm not sure about anyone else, what's your position? I won't tell anyone that we are talking by the way, hope you don't as well.

Clarence - Alright! Sounds good to me. I'm friendly with Linda as well. So far everyone I've talked to thinks Lex is going to go first from our tribe.

Frank - Everyone does seem to want to take out Lex for obvious reasons. But that can also be used as a diversion for something else. What do you think? Who would you wanna vote out that is not Lex? What if Kim J doesn't use her immunity? Should we vote for her?

While some members of the alliance are making side deals to further their position in the tribe, others are doing it for pure entertainment. The group think spins out of control and the name calling begins.

Lindsey - I think I'm totally 100% good with Diane. <3 Gosh I can't wait to see this slimy ho's face when she gets pwnt at the first TC or something.

Kim J - If we win often, we should send Lex home first. Mostly for unity. But yeah. When she leaves, and is really surprised, It'll be insanely hilarious.

Frank - Pretty much Diane thinks its just you me and Kim P. So we can't really get anywhere with her. Our agents will be Kim J and Lindsey.

Linda - So should I just out and out lie to her then? :)

Frank - Just pretend like you are not in an alliance, Linda, she knows its a lie but if you dont lie she will be suspicious.

### Mariche, Night 04

As tension in the challenge built, both tribes became annoyed with their newly appointed leaders. Kim J's approach seemed to have worked better in placifying her tribe, and winning the challenge didn't hurt either. Sarah's excuse on the other hand isn't proving to be as effective.

Gina - Hey great job in the challenge today! You killed it.

Gabriel - Thanks, Gina! You did too. Admittedly, I'm upset that we worked so hard to lose because Sarah isn't here.

**Gina** - Yeah, its pretty frustrating to know that we came together as a team in a big way and we could still potentially lose because of one person. I think there's gonna be some ill will towards Sarah. Especially from whoever gets voted out.

**Gabriel** - I have ill will. At least for now. I'm really annoyed. We need to make sure every pool in the nation is drained soon. That way Sarah can't go swimming!

Gina - I'm packing my water drainage equipment now.....

**Gabriel** - Just finished packing mine. NOW WHICH POOL IS FIRST! Really though... I don't know how to take it. I'm sure someone or another will want to vote her out.

Gina - She's immune until the merge though, I believe. So it's a moot point. I guess the question is , who's on your mind as the first boot? I'd like to think it's neither you nor I- we've both been active on the board and partook in the challenge.

**Gabriel** - The leader posts said that she COULD have immunity until the merge. That being said, you could take it as simply as you have to win immunity until the merge, or she is immune until the merge. I don't know. She was the person that cost us the challenge.

As the tribe is venting about Sarah blowing the challenge for them, it prompts John to start a 3 way alliance with Peter and Gabriel.

Peter - Well this blows.

John - I know right! And between you and I it more than kinda sucks that the one person that was almost completely responsible for our failure cant be voted out lol. What are you thinking for the vote? Are we just going to go for the weakest player so far?

Peter - That is definitely one way to go. But like, what about Sean? I haven't seen him at all to judge if he is a weak player or an amazing one that happened to be gone tonight..

**Gabriel** - Admittedly, every conversation I've had with Sean has been really short. He's not much of a talker.

John - I'm thinking exactly the same as you, Sean, I've had almost 0 contact with him so....

**Peter -** Ok so we are all three on for Sean. But with a tribe of 8, we need more than three votes. Who else do you guys think we should pull in with us?

John begins looking for other members to solidify the vote against Sean.

John - Do you have a name in mind for the vote tomorrow?

Gina - It's hard to say. I don't want to lose anyone. My vote will probably be based on who has participated the least and who I've communicated with the least. Now I've just got to figure out who that is. However, if there is a tribe consensus I'll vote that way. I think it would be good for us to vote as a unit and stay united.

John - Yeah I hear you. Between you and I, I'm thinking Sean just now, he and I have barley talked so for me his participation has been pretty much 0

Gina - Honestly, that's what I was thinking. I've heard about two words outta the guy and he wasn't present at the challenge. I'm guessing most of the tribe's experience has been similar regarding him.

John - Yeah, I think I'm pretty set on putting Sean's name down. If I hear anything different I'll let you know.

Gina - Alrighty. Ditto.

**Gina – CONFESSIONAL** - Can we talk about how much John irritates me? Even if I didn't know he was secretly in a majority alliance, I'd be able to tell just from the way he talks to me. He acts like some god on a golden pedestal who will down information to me when he pleases. He's totally smarmy. It's a shame he's probably in the most powerful position on our tribe right now, but at least he's pretty transparent. I'll enjoy voting him out.

John - I just spoke to Gina and she's on board to take out Sean so we have four. We only need one more to make it official.

Peter - I have been talking to Sarah a lot lately, I bet I could bring her in. Does that sound good?

John - Yeah that sounds like a pretty good plan to me!

**Gabriel** - Sounds really good! We'll need to playfully scold her though. Do you guys want the honest truth?

John - haha always

**Gabriel** - Around night 1, Sean asked me for an alliance with Vecepia, Sarah, and the General. I said yes, because of course it's the first night and I want to feel secure... that being said, I'd much rather work with you two.

**Peter -** No way! Really wish I wouldn't have sent that message to Sarah then.. Darn. Who does that leave us to pick up with us then?

John - Wow, interesting! Ok I'm willing to disregard all other deals that I've made with people in order to solidify us three as a proper all out alliance.

Gabriel begins playing both sides as he reveals his alliance to John and Peter, but continues to put up a front with Vecepia.

**Vecepia** - What's your thoughts on the vote tommorow. This sucks.

**Gabriel** - I don't even want to think about it right now. I'm really sort of annoyed. I'll get over it in a few minutes.

Vecepia - Me too man.

Gabriel - Oh, definitely. Who could you see us losing and still be a strong tribe?

Vecepia - Well John made the whole template. Gina put it into code but didn't communicate much.

Patricia wasn't here and Peter helped so it's a hard decision. Either Peter Gina or Pat.

**Gabriel** - Yeah. John definitely shouldn't be the first to go. It'll come down to the other members of the alliance.

Patricia - Well the game gets thrust upon us due to bullshittery of the highest order. "challenges are optional" my ass. I'm just glad I was able to help by my massive stroke of luck guess on the challenge! What are you thinking on this coming vote?

**John** - I'm not really that sure. I'm thinking Sean right now just because I haven't really spoken to him. What are you thinking?

Patricia - I was thinking Vecepia because she hasn't said 2 words to me. Sean and I have actually had a good conversation! Talked about E3 for like, 6 PMs But then again, she showed for the challenge so it's a toss up.

John - Yeah, I'm open to other ideas, if I think the majority is voting Vee I'll vote that way too lol. I'm heading to bed soon but if you hear anything let me know and I'll do likewise.

Patricia - Will do John! I feel fairly strongly of Sean staying over Vecepia because from what I've seen he's far and away more active and I think we need that. But still, a this point there's no reason to push too hard so I'll do whatever it is that's the popular move. Still, will chat tomorrow hon

**John – CONFESSIONAL** - I will flip on my four if I need to. The fact that Pat is now showing signs of weakness makes me think that if I need to vote her out at the first tribal I will. Right now I've just firmed up a "you watch my back and I'll watch yours" alliance with the General, although i still don't really trust him (but keep your friends close and all that...)

When Patricia arrives later in the day, she begins to turn the tribe consensus around.

Gina - Anyway, so, I'll catch you up since you were sick. We kicked ass at the challenge, beat them by like 20 minutes at least, and Sarah didn't show up to post the puzzle so we lost. So... I figure we ought to talk strategy now. I don't know what anyone else is thinking, but I'll say I'm thinking Sean. I've communicated with him the least and he wasn't at the challenge. I don't think that would ruffle any feathers. What are you thinking?

Patricia - That's absolutely bullshit though. "Challenges are optional" my tits. Sean actually talks a lot to me! we had a decent convo about E3. I've sent a handful of messages to Vecepia with no response so i'd be leaning her personally. Her and John are two who just really don't talk I guess gage the reaction of everyone and see who's thinking what before pushing for anyone though.

Gina - I've talked to John and Gabe, and they both seem on board for Sean. I heard from one of them that Peter is also on board for Sean. Before this challenge I would have said been inclined to say Vecepia, actually- but she did great work in the challenge. I'm still open to the possibility of voting her out, but I think the tribe is generally leaning towards Sean. Especially John, who is probably the most outspoken person in this group.

Patricia - I too have heard Sean from John. I'm putting a feeler out there for Vee though but whatever happens will happen. It'll be sad if Sean goes because he doesn't deserve to. Lex on the other tribe with all of 5 posts deserves to go But yeah, it's definitely looking like Sean at the moment. John seems to only talk about the game. He's definitely one to look out for.

Gina - yeah, I've got my eye on John. He's going to be a very aggressive player. Glad we're on the same page regarding him. For now, though, we need him.

Patricia - Well, now some enemies have gotta be made. I still think it's bullshit because in the rules it says 'Challenges are optional" and I don't see why everyone should have to suffer because Sarah decided to actually have a life outside of the internet. The quietest people to me have been John and Vecepia, and since John's in our alliance I guess Vee's where I'm kind of feeling right now? Have you heard much of anything?

**Gabriel** - I've heard that John, Peter, and Gina are all up for voting Sean. Considering Sean wasn't here and he's not really the greatest communicator, I'd probably say that's the best and easiest bet for now.

Patricia - I'm hearing much the same. It's a shame because he and I actually had a really decent talk but with the lack of participation... ugh. Voting seems so unfair once you have to do it yourself.

Patricia – CONFESSIONAL - It's between Vee and Sean. And I seem to be the only person vying for Seas I'm hoping to switch it but it's not that necessary. Sean's probably my third favourite person here at this point.

Patricia continues pushing to get Sean back in the game.

Patricia - Dude, people have got it out for you this first vote "I'm trying to keep Vecepia's name in the mix but she did well in the challenge. You need to sell your soul because I like you kid and I want you around. Please try and sway these people! John's the biggest advocate for you so try and sway General, Gina, Peter, Gabe or Sarah.

Sean - Hey, I'm here. Sorry for my absence as I had to work. Is Tribal over. Thanks for pushing for me to stay. Means a lot.

Patricia - The challenge is over, TC is tomorrow so you've got until then to pull something. But it's going to be a tough slug man, everyone's kinda leaning towards voting for you. Let me know if anyone seems open to something.

**Sean -** Yikes, looks like I got my work cut out for myself. I'll pull something off. Have you heard any other names. And who have you heard is voting for me so far?

Patricia - tbh dude... just about everyone. the only other name was Vee and that was me pushing it. I'm trying to think of a last ditch effort... it'd be crazy difficult but see if you can spread some paranoia. tell people that John was super close to you. I think your only shot is if you can convince people that John's Russell Hantzing this tribe (which tbh he sort of is)

**Sean** - theres 9 of us right? So I need 5. Gina told me she doesnt mant me to go. Vee also informed me that i was on the chopping block so thats 4 including you and myself. maybe we could swing something.

When Vecepia catches wind of Gabriel wanting to vote for Sean, she immediately feels threatened.

**Vecepia** - So I was talking to members outside of our alliance of 5 and they seem to be gunning for Sean because he wasn't at the challenge today. Someone also included your name saying that you wanted to vote him out. Is our alliance still on?

**Gabriel** - Alright, I'll be honest. OUR alliance, as in you and I, is still on. I want it to be. It's just that Sean to me is really really short and participation too is reason enough for me to want him out. I don't want to lie to anyone.

Vecepia - Wait I'm confused by how you phrased that. I'm being honest with you too.

Gabriel - I know! I was just saying. I like you, I'm honest with you. I just don't want you to throw me under the bus or anything. I don't think you will which is why I was telling you I wanted to vote for Sean and stuff. I didn't mean anything bad!

Suddenly, it's the last two tribe mates to arrive that are the most influential.

**Gina** - Alrighty, sounds like it's Sean. Regarding the General, I feel a certain level of affection towards him. He's good people. General's nice, but he seems kinda... dopey. Like, 'report every conversation I have to John' kinda dopey. And John's the kinda guy who would target someone just for strategizing without him.

Patricia - I really do feel for General as well it's clear English isn't his first language And if what you're saying is true and he is just being John's slave then that's bad news bears for us... I've got such a bad feeling about John.... especially now that you've said that. You know... and this is just a complete "what-if" idea but we could always boot him first? I mean, you say we need him but... why?! so he can keep his chickens in a row? He only talks game and it's clear he's only in for his own since he buddied up straight to

the leader who nobody's going to touch. Theoretically: you, me, Sean, and there's every chance we could convince Gabe. we'd only need one more.

Gina - I'm glad you brought it up. I was just thinking this, actually. It's clear John and Sarah are tight- and I'm all for cutting Sarah's power down to zero. That immunity is power enough already. Sean will definitely vote with us. And if you think Gabe would vote with us, I trust you. You know him better than I do

Patricia - I'm so glad you agree. Let's make this happen.

Sean - I'm worried cause i know my name has been thrown into the mix and I really dont want to leave.

Gina - I won't lie to you, it has. But I really don't want to see you go- especially considering some of the other people on our tribe. I'd hate to see you voted out first for no real reason.

Sean - Thanks Gina. I feel horrible i couldn't make it tonight and suspected taht I would be an easy vote if we lost. I'm hoping to fight to stay. I think i'd be a real asset if i was given the opportunity to prove myself. Who else would you like to see go. I'm up for any ideas. I really really dont want to go. :(

**Gina** - Basically, it's John. He's a gamebot and really, really intelligent. I'm fairly certain he's got side deals on side deals on side deals. He's running the show. If you're gonna stay in this game, it's gotta be him. I'm not sure we have a majority, but it's very, VERY possible we can have one with a little convincing.

Sean - I think right now Particia and Vee feel the same way as thats what they want to do. No one else is really messaging me back though besides you three. but with all of us that is 4. With one more flipped we can change the game and take John out.

Gina - OK, so, what have you heard regarding the next boot? I've heard names flying all around, and some people seem set on Sean. Personally, I don't want to see the guy go. What are your thoughts?

**Vecepia** - Yeah, I've also heard Sean from the others. I feel like their are others we could vote out besides him. Just because he wasn't at one challenge doesn't mean he won't participate. I feel like he's more of an asset than some others on the tribe.

Gina - I agree wholeheartedly. I think people are jumping the gun and voting him out. Who would you eliminate? I will level with you. I don't trust John. He's really shrewd and pretty forceful- to me that is a dangerous combination in this game. And if we don't eliminate him when we have the chance, we may regret it. I dunno, that's just a thought. Who do you think?

Vecepia - Yeah I'll agree with you about John. I don't think many people are willing to vote him out though because of his challenge performance.

Gina - I think it would be more than you'd think. A majority, actually, if you help us. Personally, now that I think we've got the hang of challenges, we'll do great. We can take his ideas and move forward. I just think that if we don't do something now we'll regret it later. I know your name was tossed around as a boot option a little bit, and I'm fairly certain mine was as well. And personally I'd like to see us stay in the game a little longer than 17th and 16th place...

Sean - Hey Guys, I figured i'd build this thread so the four of us could talk and hopefully get John out of here this tribal. I'm very appreciative of you all supporting me. It appears the key to be Gabe and the General. If we can work on getting one of the two of them we'll be golden. I think we can get Gabe but if we can get the general too that would be awesome.

**Vecepia** - Yeah, John seems like he would turn against you in a second. We just need enough people for the vote. I'd also try and talk to Sarah.

Sean - For sure, lets hit up every avenue we can.

Patricia - Do any of you guys have any idea wtf is up with Peter? It's kinda hilarious.

Gina - Peter is a mystery to me. I'm not even gonna bother with him right now because he's just so odd. He's totally unpredictable. And I think I accidentally only sent a message to Sean last time. I really don't think we should talk with Sarah- I think she's really close with John and he may get tipped off and damage control like crazy. He wants to be here badly.

Patricia - Agreed. So it seems like we've all got our jobs to do, and hopefully one of us will strike gold! I'm really happy with you guys. Much happier than I was before when it seemed like John/Sarah were going to control everything.

Patricia gains Gabriel's trust by creating a lie about John.

**Patricia – CONFESSIONAL** - Fuck it I'm going for it. I don't trust John and I like Sean. Go hard or go home. One of those two will happen to me or John. Gabe's close with John/Peter so there's something. I think my best bet, is Gina/Pat/Sean and then it's down to Gabe. if I can get him to doubt John, then he might be able to convince Peter alongside. Vecepia's a wild-card and General is apparently completely up John's Arse. If the move isn't made now, then John's got everyone under his thumb.

Patricia - I check my phone 5 minutes later and crazy stuff happens Apparently John was mentioning you as an alternative to Sean going? I mean, we both know that he wants Sean gone but why would he throw your name around as the 'alternate'?

**Gabriel** - I seriously have no idea. I was the first one to post the finished puzzle, whilst working REALLY hard and getting stuff together while he was doing the template. And he messaged me for an alliance on like, Day 2. That really annoys me. I want him out!

### Mariche, Day 05

Sean approaches Sarah about the vote only to find out that she is not going along with anyone's plan and voting based completely on personal preference.

Sean - Hey Sarah, Glad I caught you before tribal tonight. So whats the plan for the vote? I heard my name floating around so I'm really really nervous.

Sarah - I'm going with Gina personally. She hasn't spoken to me at all and I don't see where she helped at the challenge.

Sean - Thanks Sarah. I'm really down for voting whichever way. I'm just not ready to go.

Sarah - Sean, we're good. I'm going to vote Gina, I don't have anyone else but if you want to help me out you're more than welcome to.

Sean - I'll see what I can do:)

Sarah - Alright, awesome.

**Sarah – CONFESSIONAL** - I've decided I'm going to throw a vote to Gina. She doesn't even talk to me and I don't see where she did a good job in the challenge. I don't have to vote in the majority and I'm happy for that. If I was vulnerable I probably would have gone with a safer choice like Sean but I don'thave to do anything. I'm not leaving, they can't vote for me, it's all good. By the way I might have forgotten to mention this but Gabriel and I got a side alliance with Pat and John.

When approached by other members of the tribe, Sarah is sticking to her guns.

**Vecepia** - Peter hasn't been talking much.

Sarah - I disagree. Peter is a help in challenges.

Vecepia - I know. Have you talked to John or Peter. I haven't heard what they'be said.

Sarah isn't the only one voting with their gut. The General is proving to be a hard sell.

**Vecepia** - We have a couple options open. Some people think John is dishonest.

**General** - I dont really understand why everyone think this way of John. And hes been useful in that challenge. Anyway, I think I'll go with the majority and hope the vote will be unanimous.

John - I'm not really sure what we should do, the name I keep hearing is Sean so I think that is how I will go. I like the guy but I guess his absence has annoyed a few people which makes it an easy vote I guess General - Yeah I did heard his name. I just want to make this vote unanimous and I'll doubt its gonna be. I've heard your name and Gina thrown around. I've got no idea what will happen yet.

General - It sucks for last night. Finally you are NOT optional for challenge I guess: / What do you think we should do? What name did you heard? So far I've only heard Gina targetting John. So do you have any

Sarah - I'm thinking Gina personally. She doesn't talk to me and I don't think she's helpful at all.

General - I've heard John and Sean name. You're actually the first that is bringing up Gina. I just want this to be unanimous.

Sarah - I'm voting Gina regardless.

Gabriel - We haven't talked about the vote yet! Not sure if you've been busy or not so I was waiting until you sent me one. Tribal is sooner now than later though so I decided to shoot you one instead. What are you thinking?

Sarah - I'm voting Gina personally. I don't know about anyone else.

Gabriel - Oh, really? Have you talked with many people?

Sarah - Well, most of the tribe knows the way I'm voting. They are welcome to vote in their own majority.

Gabriel - Alright. Why are you voting that way?

With members of the tribe going roque the vote is further complicated when the alliance that John has formed continues to push for a Sean boot.

Peter - Ok everyone, if We all 5 stay with Sean, everyone who participated in the challenge and have been adding to our tribe will stay. I can say that Sarah and heneral have throw out John.. So we really need you Pat and Gina! Lets keep this tribe strong with people who want to win and help this tribe

grow. Cheers 💖



Gabriel - Good pep talk!

Peter - Thanks! Another curve ball.. I just saw Gina's name pulled up. So we just need to make sure us 5 are strong and it doesn't matter what else happens!

Just as the alliance against Sean strengthens, the alliance against John is starting to weaken.

Vecepia - So, can anyone explain why exactly we are voting out John. You guys are saying he is dishonest and cunning. I haven't talked to him enough to get this vibe from him so can you guys please elaborate? Sean - I selected John as he was gunning for me hardcore and lying to me about it. I understand he may be strong but he seems to have an over bearing personality. Those are my personal reasons that I wanted to vote him. Did you have something else in mind Vecepia?

Vecepia - I just wanted the reasoning behind the vote. I was also thinking someone like Peter but he seems like you could vote him out any other time.

Sean - Yea, Peter wouldn't be a bad choice. but like you said we could probably pick him off any other time we chose. Gina wont be here and she's already sent in her pre-vote. Idk what do you guys think? I'm all for taking out John but if you feel more comfortable with Peter and we can get another vote maybe we can sway that way.

Gina - What in the sam hill is going on around here. Is everyone still good on john? This is nuts.

Patricia - Ok Peter's seriously weird. I just got a message from Sarah saying they're voting for you now?! wtf?

Gina - Um, was there a reason given why? And who exactly?

Patricia - Peter is fucking 'tarded?! I asked Sarah I was like "Peter said you wanted John gone?" and she was like "No. Gina." that was the entire message. Then she followed up later with "Gina's a quiet player and not a physical asset." From what I can tell Peter/John/Sarah are a tight 3 that need to be broken up. And you, me, sean need to pray that gabe, vecepia and general are telling the truth and voting with us.

Patricia - Well Peter just mentioned that he's heard Sarah and General both wanting John out as

**Sean** - People from the other side haven't really been giving me much info on whats happening because of obvious reasons.

Patricia – We need to stand strong.

Sean - Yikes. Got butterflies in my stomach for this tribal.

Heading into Tribal Council, there are alliances everywhere, rogue voters and several power players colliding. There's an alliance with John against Sean, an alliance with Sean against John, and everyone is doubting their position in the game and the reasons they are voting for who they are supposed to.

### Mariche Tribal Council #1, Night 05

Jeff Probst – HOST - Welcome Mariche to your first Tribal Council as a new tribe.

Tonight and at every tribal council, votes will be due 30 minutes after the starting time. Tonight they will be due at 8:30c/9:30e. Any vote cast after that time will not count. You can change your vote at any time until then.

Sarah, as the tribe Cacique, you have Individual Immunity at tonight's council and any future council in which you remain the Cacique. One of your other 8 tribemates will not be so lucky.

#### Jeff Probst – HOST – Has Sarah been a good leader thus far?

Patricia - I wasn't there but I think you know exactly how she did. Neither Cacique was there and so it was more of which came online first rather than which tribe worked together better.

Sarah - I'm going to say it now, you guys need to stop telling people I'm voting with you when I have made it no secret who I'm voting for.

**Sean** - Unfortunately I was not here last night when everything went down. I think Sarah did a good job overall. She stepped up as the leader not knowing what to expect. She been great rolling with everything and is a very optimistic leader.

**Jeff Probst** - Patricia, you showed up later than most of your tribemates on that first night, are you still playing catch up?

Patricia - I certainly hope not. My tribe-mates reassured me that I had not missed anything vitally important apart from Sarah's election, and luckily I was able to help my tribe in the challenge with that guide for image posting despite not being able to attend myself.

**Gina** - Well, sarah ruffled some feathers by missing the challenge and causing us to lose. She's personable enough and I'm confident she'll be fine in the future, but this first tribal council someone is leaving because of her. End of story.

Personally, her and I haven't been that talkative. Moving forward, I'd like to forge a better bond with her because I do like her and think she has a lot of potential.

**Vecepia** - I think Sarah has done well as Tribe leader. She may have missed the challenge, but so did the other leader. She is holding the tribe together and that is important.

Jeff Probst - HOST - Sean, do you feel relatively safe tonight?

**Sean** - I feel like you should never feel safe at tribal council because you never know when you are going to go. It could be just when you feel the safest.

I dont feel safe at all tonight unfortunately. I know my name has been brought up, and some messages I sent were never replied to which puts that sinking feeling in your stomach.

**Peter -** When it comes down to it, if any of us were voted as leader, we may end up missing a challenge along time in the game. It was very unfortunate for it being the first challenge and all, but everyone here is human and has their own lives.

**Sarah** - Alright, I'm going to be honest. Gina, my vote is going to you tonight. I feel like we haven't spoken as much as I'd like and that makes me uncomfortable. I honestly don't care if you stay tonight, I think you need this warning shot to be honest. Step it up.

Jeff Probst – HOST - Sarah, are you okay with sharing who you are voting for tonight or is it generally well known?

Sarah - I'm pretty sure the whole tribe knows by now and Gina probably knows by now. It doesn't bother me and I'm not ashamed of it.

Patricia - To be perfectly honest Sarah, I'd also wager that your immunity gives you more freedom than the rest of us to exclaim our intentions.

Sarah - Oh, it does.

Mia Galeotalanza – HOST - Gina- How do you respond to Sarah telling you that she's voting for you? How do you make a case to stay over someone else?

**Gina** - Sarah- to be fair, we've put in the same level of communication to each other. If I survive the vote I hope we can build rapport and friendship, but don't act like this is a one way street.

**Jeff Probst** - You have 15 minutes to change your vote should you want to, or if you haven't already, you have 15 minutes to get your votes in.

Peter - Do we cast our votes out loud here? Or where at?

**Jeff Probst** - You can cast your vote here if you want, but if you prefer to do so in private you can do it in your confessionals under the voting thread.

**General** - in your confessionnal Peter!

**Mia Galeotalanza** - Sean: Let's get back to Sarah's leadership role. What happens if Sarah ~ISN'T~ the leader you all hoped for?

Sean - I feel like she is the leader that we wanted. There was a confidence in her that first night and I'm sure we're going to see it on the next challenge. Personally I dont think we made any mistake electing her.

Jeff Probst - Alright Mariche, at this time all votes are final.

# I'll go tally the votes.

Sean - \*heart racing\*

Patricia - I've got my tray table up, and my seat back in the full upright position.

**Jeff Probst** - I have the votes. Once the votes have been read, the person voted off will be asked to leave the tribal council area immediately.
